CroomsCon: More Gaming, More Sponsors, More Charity!





Aditya (AJ) Patel,

AJ Patel is a serial entrepreneur who thrives in finding opportunity not only in ideas but in mentoring people that can help grow those ideas. His visionary instincts and out-of-thebox thinking have led him on a successful journey of becoming a leader in both his business ventures and in his community.

As a sophomore in high school, AJ launched and sold his first web hosting business and used the proceeds to help pay for college. During his college years, AJ dabbled in internet companies, gaming, staffing agencies, and real estate, all of which taught him valuable lessons and the ultimate realization that he did not want to work for someone else.

By the time AJ graduated from college, he had saved up close to six figures from his internet ventures and was determined to continue down the entrepreneurial path. Unfortunately, he hit a few roadblocks and ended up working for a couple of years in corporate America as an accountant while actively looking for other opportunities. Throughout this time, he regularly reminded himself that taking risks and great achievements often involve challenges, even failures, yet are an opportunity to grow and learn — an ideology his parents instilled in him from an early age. In late 2013, after stumbling upon how to sell on Amazon, he took the risk of going

into debt and charged \$40K on his credit card to launch the nature-inspired beauty brand InstaNaturalâ which is now a top-ranking, e-commerce beauty brand.

Since then, AJ has founded five other CPG brands from the ground up three of which have each grown to a nine-figure enterprise value. His success record can be attributed to staying ahead of the curve and avoiding complacency through innovation and aggressive growth plans. With over a decade of operating experience and e-commerce expertise, AJ has developed an invaluable toolkit for growing and expanding the footprint of his brands. AJ credits much of his success to his dedicated employee group of motivated team players who thrive in a culture of hyper-growth.

HighKey, AJ's most recent brand venture, was born out of his sweet tooth and love of chocolate chip cookies. At the time, he was on a low-carb diet and was frustrated with the sweet options available on the market. AJ decided to solve the problem himself by tapping into online communities to see firsthand what consumers felt was missing in the low-carb space. He found that there were lots of health-conscious consumers who were also seeking better-for-you products that taste just as good as the original. So, he put his team to work and they were able to create a successful go-to-market strategy. Since the initial 2018 chocolate-chip cookie launch, HighKey has continued its upward growth trajectory and has moved into the retail space while staying committed to the better-for-you food trend and amazing tasting products.

AJ has been recognized both in his local community and nationally for his trade and business contributions. He was honored and humbled to have been named a 2019 Florida Finalist for Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of The Year, and the 2019 Gold Stevie® Award Winner for Entrepreneur of the Year.
